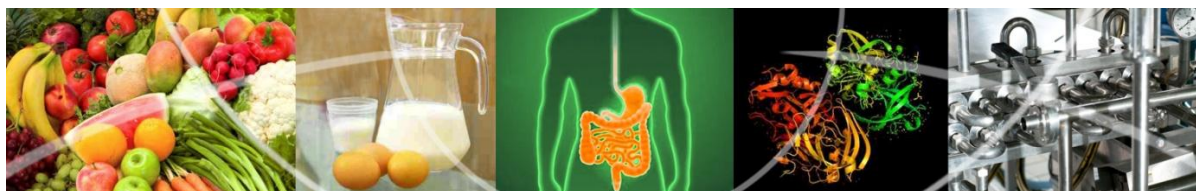


COST Action FA 1005

Location of dinners:

Dinner on Day 1 will be in the “[Fresco Restaurant](#)” in the Glucksman Gallery on the grounds of University College Cork on Western Road, 5 minutes walk from River Lee Hotel.

Lunches and Dinners:

Lunches and dinners will be paid individually. Reservation have been made for the 3 meals (Dinner day 1 & 2, Lunch day 2). We will ask you the **payment of 60 EUROS in cash upon your arrival, Unique accepted method of payment.**

Hotel accommodation:

Hotel rooms have been block-booked at **River Lee Hotel**, where the meeting will take place on Monday afternoon and Wednesday morning. Rooms need to be confirmed and paid for individually no later than 6 January 2013_ After January 6, the promotional rates (€99) does not apply anymore but attendants can book into hotels nearby such as Lancaster lodge (www.lancasterlodge.com/) or B&B's on Western road.

Aer Lingus (www.aerlingus.com) have daily flights to and from the main European hubs London, Paris and Amsterdam. Ryanair has several daily flights to and from destination in the UK.

By bus to River Lee Hotel:

Cork Airport is accessible by Buses and Coaches daily. From Cork Airport you can reach Cork City Centre, Parnell Place Bus Station (about 15 min). The River Lee hotel is a 15 min walk from the bus station or a short Taxi ride (10-15 min), at your own expense (not covered by COST).
