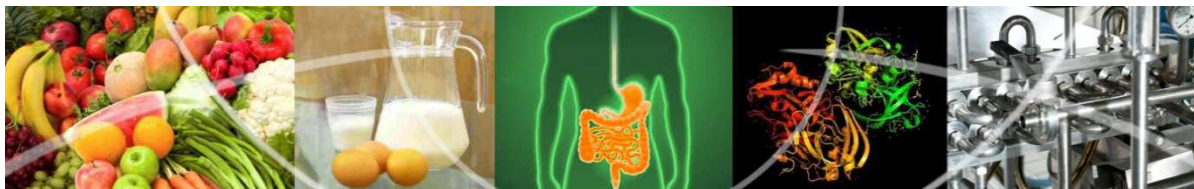


# COST Action FA 1005

### How to travel to Lisbon – how to join the meeting:

#### From Lisbon airport to INSA:

You can choose by Metro (app. 1h) or to go by taxi, which will cost approx. 10€ (luggage not included; app. 15 min.) or to go. You can take the Metro Red Line to Saldanha and then change to the Yellow Line, to *Campo Grande*. Then a 10 min-walk from Metro to INSA going around Alvalade Sports Stadium or take BUS 747 or 767 to bus stop Inst. Ricardo Jorge (1st stop, app. 3 min). (see figure)

**From Lisbon airport to SANA Hotel:** Metro will be a good option which is close to the airport: take the red line from Airport to Saldanha station and the hotel is nearby.

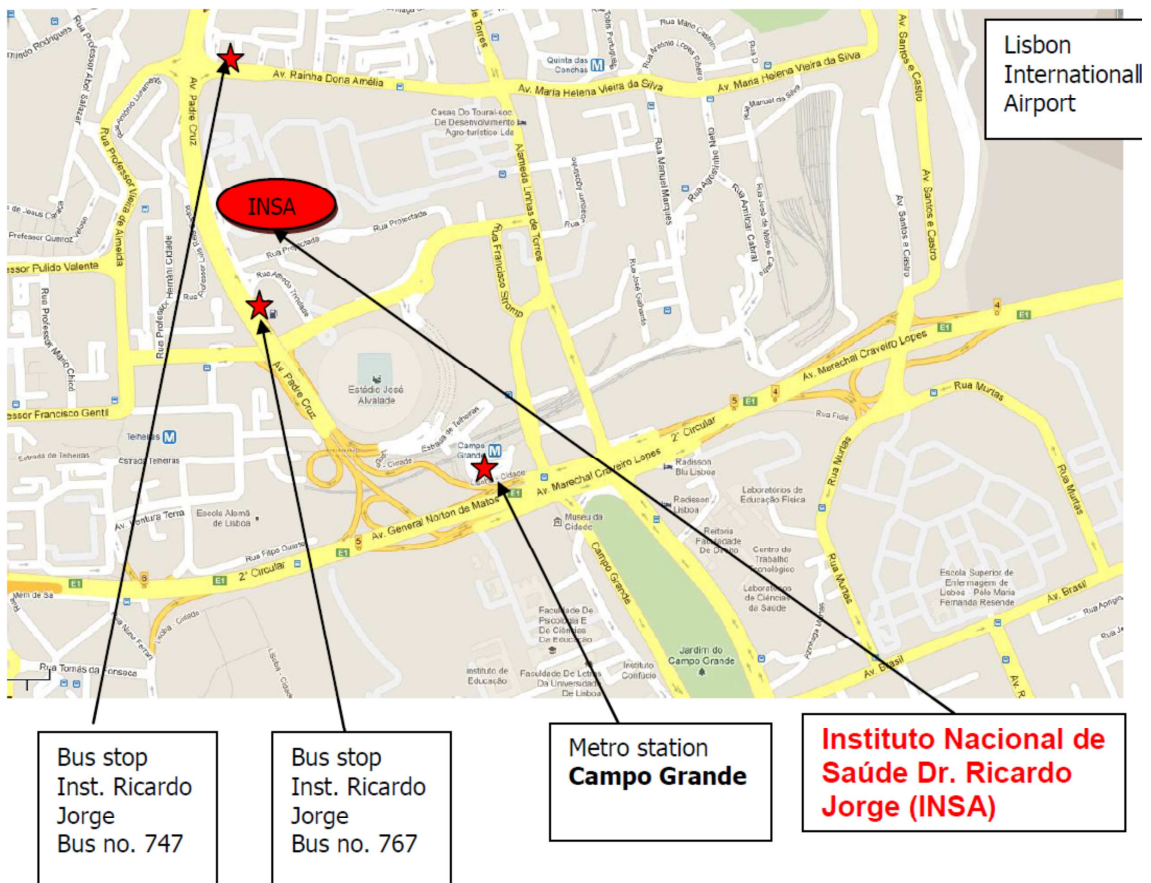
**From Hotel to INSA:** Metro is a good option. Take the the Yellow Line from Saldanha to *Campo Grande*. Then a 10 min-walk from Metro to INSA going around Alvalade Sports Stadium or take BUS 747 or 767 to bus stop Inst. Ricardo Jorge (1st stop, app. 3 min). (see figure)

## ***Tickets***

For BUS (company name is Carris) you can buy 2 types of tickets:

**-On-board ticket** - acquired on board and valid for a single journey on any route in urban and suburban regular service- € 1.75.

**- From the machines - electronic tickets previously charged on a non-contact support card (7 Colinas or Viva Viagem).** Carris Sales Network has different posts and there are machines in all metro stations. The ticket is valid on Carris and Metro; the price of a single journey is 1.25€.

For Subway (METRO) you can buy tickets at any station with the following fares:
